

When preparing your abstract, please follow the instructions carefully:

- ECDMFR 2020 allows the submission of **abstracts** for **original contributions** in the field only (the study/case report must not have been published elsewhere).
- The study/case report must be submitted via the online Abstract Submission Service only <https://ecdmfr.eu/registration/>
- The **deadline** for abstract submission is **February 29th, 2020**
- Each presenting author is allowed to present **up to 2 abstracts** with one paid registration
- When you enter the system, you have to indicate if you are also applying for a travel grant, research award, research fellowship

Choose the presentation form you prefer (oral or poster presentation).

List Authors/Affiliations:

You may enter up to 20 authors in the authors list and up to 10 affiliations. The presenter must be one of the authors listed in the submitted study/case report. The names of authors will be published as listed in the submission form. Please make sure you have entered the full list of authors.

Keywords:

You can include up to five keywords. The keywords should be selected from Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) to be used for indexing of articles. See: <http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/MBrowser.html> for information on the selection of keywords.

ABSTRACT:

- The abstract must be written in English, using font Times New Roman, font size 11 and single-line spacing
- Special characters in the title or body of the abstract or in the co-author's names or affiliations should be used according to instructions in the submission system to avoid formatting errors.

TITLE:

- Shouldn't exceed **150 characters**.
- CAPITALIZE the entire title.
- Spell out all words.
- Do not use abbreviations
- Check that your title is complete in case you copy and paste it into the field

BODY TEXT:

Two kinds of abstracts may be submitted:

- **Study abstracts** should be arranged using the following headings:
 - Aim, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusions
- **Case report abstract** should be arranged using the following headings:
 - Background, Case description, Conclusion.

The abstract shouldn't exceed **250 words**

- Do not include authors, institutions, city and abbreviations in the title or in the text since the grading and selection process is blinded.
- Do not include grant acknowledgements in the study/case report content. Do not cite keywords or references in the study/case report, as they are not allowed and will be deleted.

The abstract will be accepted according to scientific merit.

Participants who consider submitting case reports would not be prioritized for oral presentations

The final selection of abstracts will be performed by the Local Organizing Scientific Committee after the final deadline has closed and before the deadline for early bird registration for the congress. The corresponding authors will be notified about the outcome (accepted or not accepted) of the review process.

Please ensure that the email address provided during the study/case report submission is accurate, as all correspondence will be via email.

NOTE:

Registration is compulsory. In order to present an study/case report during the congress the presenting (corresponding) author has to register and pay the registration fee at the latest on April 15, 2020. If the registration fee hasn't been paid before deadline, the abstract will not be included in the final programme.

From April 15th the scientific programme is set and abstracts cannot be withdrawn.
