Dr. Gahl Greenberg is a graduate of the Hebrew University-Hadassah Medical School in Jerusalem, Israel. He completed his residency in Diagnostic Radiology at the Meir Medical Center in Kfar Saba, affiliated with the Sackler school of Medicine, Israel in 2006.
